The following extracts from the Rules and Bye-Laws of the Club are printed for the guidance of the applicant at the time of submitting application for membership:

The entrance Fee and First Annual Subscription shall be payable immediately upon notification of election. If not paid within one month after election, the election will become null and void.

Subject to official starting times and order of play for the day being observed, players for Club competitions have precedence, both in starting and through the Green, over parties playing ordinary matches.

No player should drive from the tee until the players in front have played their second strokes and are out of range, nor play up to the putting Green until the players in front have holed out and moved away.

Players who have holed out, should not try their putts over again, when other players are following them.

Players looking for a lost ball must allow other matches coming up to pass them.

Priority on the course is determined by a group's pace of play and any group losing ground on those in front should allow a following group to pass regardless of the size of that group. Any group playing a whole round may claim the right to pass a group playing a shorter round.

A single player has no standing and must always give way to a properly constituted match.

Turf cut or displaced by a stroke should at once be replaced.

A player should carefully fill up all holes made by him or herself in a bunker and repair all pitch marks on the green.

No dogs are allowed in the Clubhouse, its precincts or on the Course.
